<p>Readiness for Learning</p>	42%	50% PUYALLUP SCHOOL DISTRICT
<p>School Climate</p> <p>Perceptions of the overall social and learning climate of the school.</p>	53%	63% PUYALLUP SCHOOL DISTRICT
<p>School Fit</p> <p>Families’ perceptions of how well a school matches their child’s developmental needs.</p>	51%	61% PUYALLUP SCHOOL DISTRICT
<p>School Safety</p> <p>Perceptions of student physical and psychological safety at school.</p>	47%	69% PUYALLUP SCHOOL DISTRICT

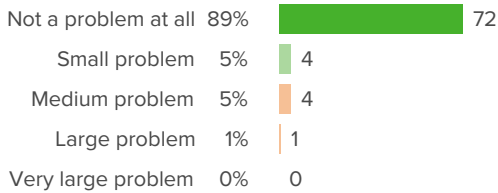

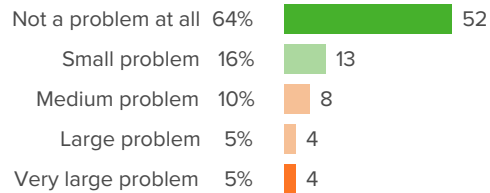

Q.1: How big of a problem is the following issue for becoming involved with your child's current school: Childcare needs?



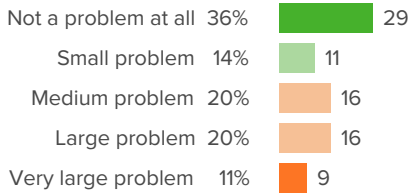

Q.2: How big of a problem is the following issue for becoming involved with your child's current school: Transportation-related challenges?



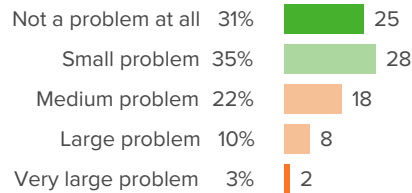

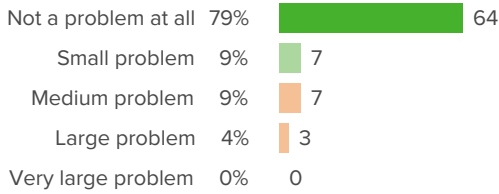

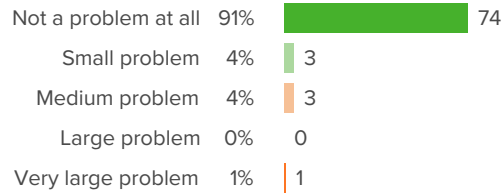

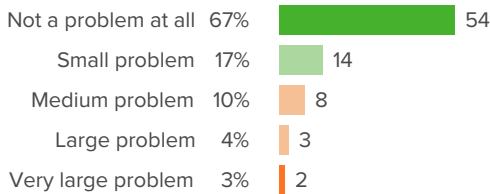

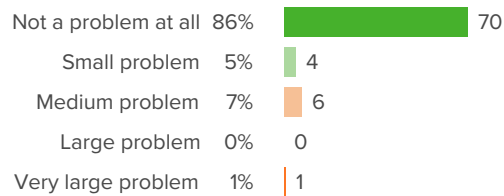

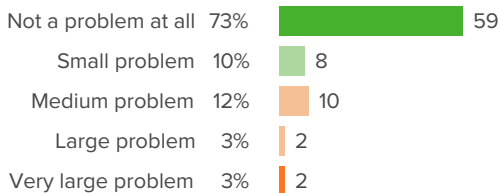

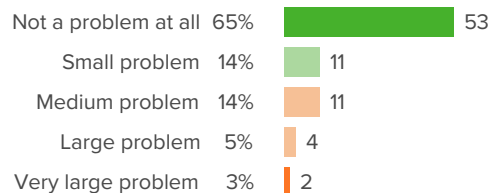

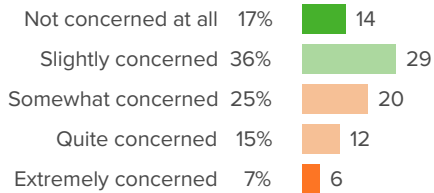

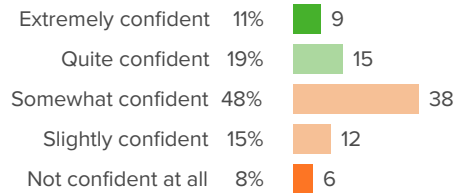

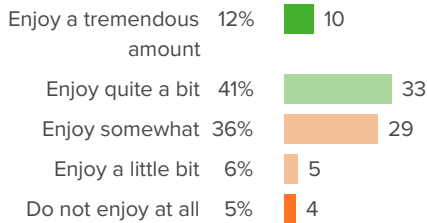

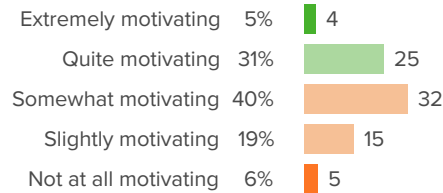

Q.1: To what extent do you think that children enjoy going to your child's school?



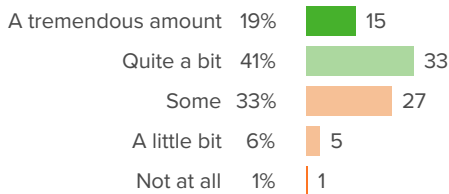

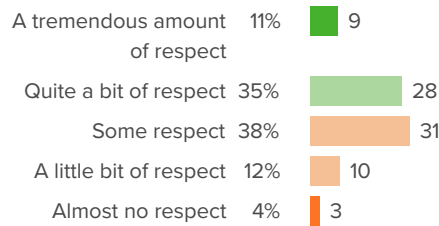

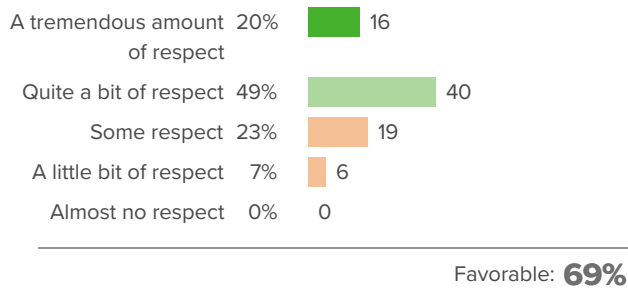
Q.4: Overall, how much respect do you think the children at your child's school have for the staff?

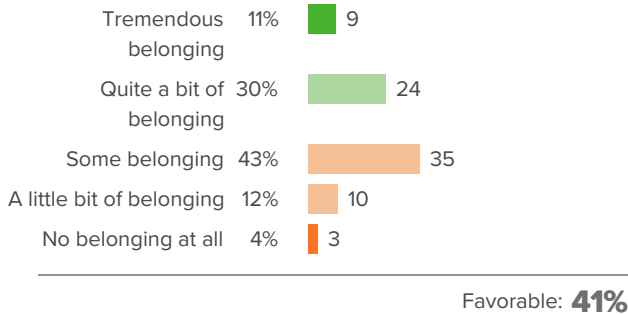

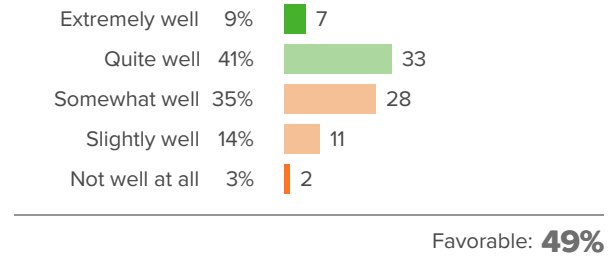

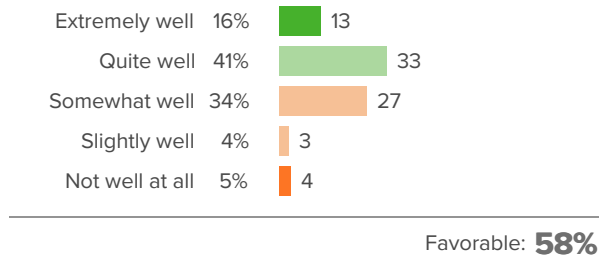
Q.1: How much of a sense of belonging does your child feel at his/her school?



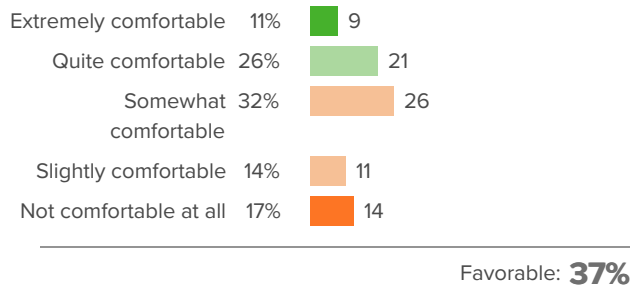
Q.2: How well do you feel your child's school is preparing him/her for his/her next academic year?



Q.3: At your child's school, how well does the overall approach to discipline work for your child?

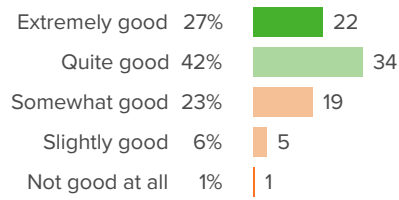


Q.4: How comfortable is your child in asking for help from school adults?

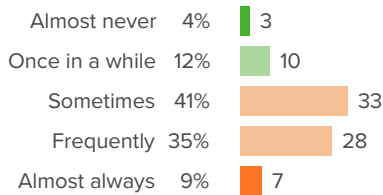

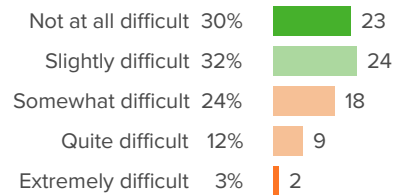

Q.1: How often do you worry about violence at your child's school?



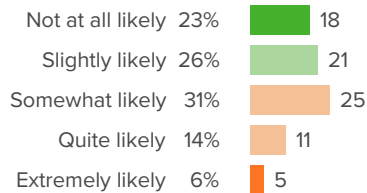

Q.2: If a student is bullied at your child's school, how difficult is it for him/her to get help from an adult?



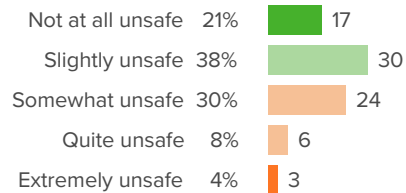

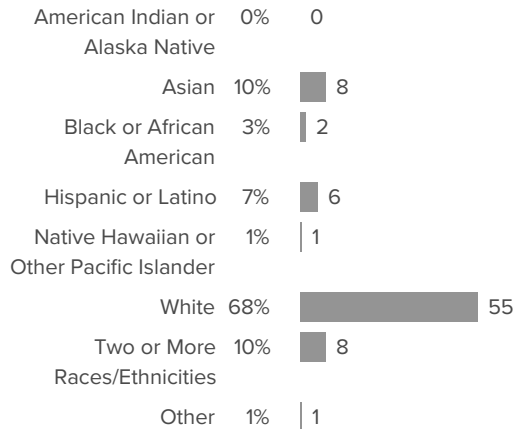

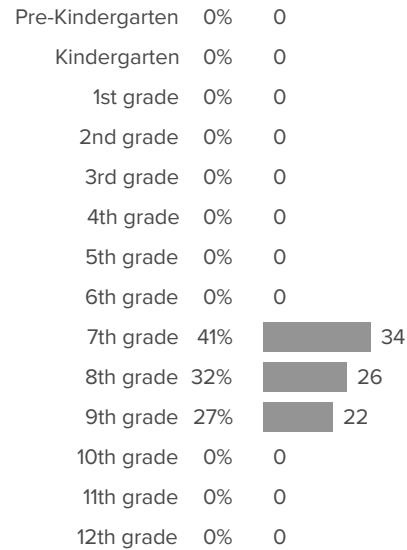
