

Capital Levy Project Descriptions

All Weather Tracks	Provides for year-round use and reduce ponding, puddling, mud; safer for students in class and athletics; includes all-weather long-jump tracks and high jump landing zones.
Digital Readerboard Upgrades	Provides roadside reader boards to improve communication with families and community.
Door Entry Intercom Lifecycle Replacement	Replaces outdated/end of life systems used for clear two-way communication and for buzzing in visitors to control access to school buildings.
Door Hardware Keying	Re-keys all interior and exterior door locks to limit access to buildings and eliminate potential for key duplication; allows first responders easy access when necessary.
Fire Alarm System Field Device Improvements	Replaces end of life /obsolete smoke detectors, heat detectors, pull stations, and notification devices.
Fire Sprinkler System Upgrades	Replaces end of life /obsolete fire sprinkler heads.
Heating & Cooling System Replacement	Replaces water source heat pumps, boilers, air handlers, pumps, and other HVAC components to maintain comfortable learning and working environments.
Intercom System Upgrades	Standardizes and updates building intercom systems to provide efficient and rapid communication and the ability to trigger pre-recorded messages between classrooms and main office for campus lockdown, shelter-in-place, and other emergency communications.
Intrusion Alarm System Replacement	Replace obsolete intrusion alarm system panel and alarm keypads, motion detectors, glass break detectors, and other components to protect students, staff, and property.
Lighting Upgrades	Replaces exit and emergency lighting, parking lot lighting, and replace interior lighting fixtures to maintain proper light levels for staff and student wellness and safety/security, and energy efficiency.

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Lockdown Visual Alert Strobe Lights

Installs strobe lights in large spaces like gymnasiums, commons, and music rooms to ensure students and staff have a visual alert alerted to emergency communications for lockdowns, shelter-in-place, etc.

Network Upgrade

Upgrades district's network to provide sufficient bandwidth for the high demand we experience based on the increased number and capability of devices needing to access our network; the implementation of our one-to-one initiative, increased digital curriculum, and other similar technology needs has greatly increased the demand on our systems which are designed for the technology needs of 8 years ago.

New Audio Visual Classroom Systems

Provides technology equity for all classrooms that don't have the current technology system standards including teacher voice amplification systems, interactive screens, and document cameras that allow for enhanced student engagement.

Parking Lot Improvements

Cleans, repairs, seals asphalt and re-stripes parking lots.

Paved Walking Paths

Provides six-foot wide asphalt path around grass fields to provide clean and safe path for year-round physical activity for students and staff.

Phone System

Replaces aging phone handsets with a more efficient and lower cost cloud-based communication system per FCC mandate and to ensure clear communication with families and community.

Playground Equipment

Provides new playground equipment for all grade levels to ensure safe and inclusive play for all students.

Replacement Synthetic Turf Field

Replaces end-of-life synthetic turf on high school fields to ensure safe playing surface.

Roof Replacement

Replaces aging roofs to maintain integrity of the building and minimize damage from leaks.

Rubber Tile Playground Fall Protection

Replaces current wood chip surface with safer rubberized play tiles to reduce injuries and provide inclusive play by all students.

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Secure Entry Vestibule	Provides single entry to main office for check-in to reduce access to interior of buildings upon entry; provides for safety check of visitors entering our buildings.
Security Camera Lifecycle Improvement	Replace outdated/end of life cameras to ensure maintenance of camera coverage and connectivity to the network to maximize student and staff safety.
Siding Replacement/ Clean & Seal Brick	Replaces aging exterior siding of buildings, painting, and clean/seal brick to prevent moisture damage and provide aesthetic improvements to district buildings and prolong the life of the buildings.
Speed Zone Safety Improvements	Improves school speed zone safety with Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFPs) at select crosswalks; installation of school speed zone signage with flashing beacons (project pending city/county approval).
Student Pick-up & Drop-off Traffic Flow Improvements	Re-routes dropoff/pickup areas to maximize traffic efficiency and minimize congestion; will also include right-of-way improvements like sidewalks and turn lanes.
Two Additional Tennis Courts	Installs additional tennis courts to provide for adequate space for tournaments (PHS, RHS, ERHS).
