Berrien RESA Biennial Election Notice

BERRIEN SPRINGS-Berrien RESA's Board of Education has scheduled its biennial election to be held on Monday June 7, 2021 at 5:30 pm. The election is being held to fill two seats, both for six-year terms expiring June 30, 2027. The seats are currently held by Board Vice President Dave Pagel and Trustee Cathy Bair.

After nearly 50 years of Board service at Berrien RESA and other local school districts, Mrs. Bair will not be seeking reelection. The Berrien RESA Board of Education and the Berrien County education community thank Mrs. Bair for her lifetime commitment to supporting students. It is anticipated that Mr. Pagel will run for reelection.
