

## Closing IEP for NON-PUBLIC STUDENTS – Program Only

If the nonpublic student only qualifies for a special education program (i.e. EI, SRR, SLD, etc.) and no services (i.e. SLP, OT, PT, etc.) and the parent elects to keep their child in the nonpublic setting follow the steps below:

When in the IEP select Yes for Nonpublic School question:

It's also important to note that the district is still responsible for keeping track of these students who are found eligible for special education but whose parents have chosen to enroll them in a non-public setting. The district of location must offer a re-determination of eligibility at least every 36 months
