Technical Education Scholarship is available to qualified applicants as follows:

- \$800 per semester-top ranked senior, \$400 per semester-2nd ranked senior from Technology Centers in Carthage, Crowder-Neosho, Lamar, Franklin-Joplin, Nevada, & Scott-Monett
- Full-time enrollment within 1 year of high school graduation
- Renewable up to three consecutive semesters with a minimum 3.0 GPA and successful completion of a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester

Franklin Adult Education Scholarship

Scholarship waives the application fee to any full-time program, (Dental Assistant, Respiratory Care, Practical Nursing, Medical Assistant, Automotive Technology, Collision Repair, HVAC, & Welding) as well as \$1,000 off of tuition costs.

Scholarship requirements:

- Applicants must commit to continue their education the semester following graduation.
