

COVID SAFETY PROTOCOLS FOR SENIOR PROM

To mitigate the spread of COVID, the following safety measures will be in place for prom:

- All seniors will attend pre-prom meeting on June 10th during period 5 (in person if you are in the building or on Zoom if you are remote) to review prom rules and procedures.
- All seniors will complete google form to acknowledge rules and procedures addressed in the meeting.
- All seniors must complete COVID screening prior to attending prom. If you do not pass the COVID screening, you must stay home.
- All seniors will be temperature-checked by staff at The Castle.
- All seniors are required to properly wear masks while walking around or dancing.
- Extra masks will be available for all seniors.
- Hand sanitizing stations will set up throughout the premises.
- Tables will be limited to eight (8) people, and students may not change/join tables.
- The Castle will provide servers to assist students with the buffet and limit the surfaces that are touched.
- Seniors will be called up to the buffet in groups to minimize crowding during dinner.

Dancing will be permitted during prom as long as masks are worn. Dancing will be “at your own risk” as we know that being in close quarters increases the chances of COVID spreading. Seniors are asked to be mindful of their space on the dance floor and to respect the wishes of classmates who do not wish to dance or who prefer to have more space around them when dancing.

Additionally, as you plan any post-prom activities, we ask that you keep in mind our graduation date of Thursday, June 24th. If you are identified as a close contact of someone who tests positive and are not vaccinated and/or have not had COVID in the past three months, you will be required to quarantine. If your *last* contact with the person who tested positive is on Sunday, June 13th, your quarantine will end just in time for you to attend graduation. If your last contact is on Monday, June 14th, you will *not* be able to attend graduation because you will still be quarantined. Please keep these dates in mind as you go about your planning.
