- Parents will be invited to attend a meeting to inform them of school goals, objectives, the State of Texas Assessment of Academic Readiness (STAAR), Title I Schoolwide Program, and the Texas Academic Progress Report.
- Every Six Weeks, teachers will provide report cards for parents and arrange for parental conferences as requested.
- Every student will receive a progress report the 3rd week of the six weeks so parents can monitor student progress.
