## Transportation

Mr. Fanich rendered the following report for the Transportation Committee:

1. Adopted Guidelines to govern the Transportation Committee's Inter and Intra Committee Activities.
2. Recommends that:

A Special Meeting of the Qualified Voters of the District be held as soon as legally possible after proper notification.

The purpose of the meeting is for the public to vote upon the following proposition:

That pupils of grades K-6 residing a distance of .7 miles or more from the school building they attend be transported to and from such school at district expense. There will be no additional appropriation of funds to implement this proposal.

The authorization by the public to transport pupils of grades 7-12 inclusive for distances of one mile or more has already been given. In essence, the Committee is recommending to the Board that it seek authorization to reduce the distance a child of Grades K-6 must walk from one mile to more than .7 of one mile.
