The Ellenville Police Department recently became a certified Opiate Overdose program center for the training of the administration and distribution of Naloxone (Nar Can). This agency announces that it will conduct a free training to anyone interested in becoming certified in the administration of Naloxone. The course will be conducted by our New York State trained and certified instructors. The course will take about 90 minutes to complete for those that are interested in taking this program.

The class will be held in the court room of Village Hall at 2 Elting Court, in the Village of Ellenville. It will be held on Thursday May 17, 2018 from 600pm to 800pm, all participants will be issued a Naloxone kit upon successful completion of the program.
