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The Board of Education of Garden City USD 457 met in regular session on Monday, October 7, 2019, at 6:00 p.m. in the Cafeteria at Kenneth Henderson Middle School, 2406 N. Fleming, Garden City, Kansas.

1. Recognition of Bernadine Sitts Intermediate Center for receiving the Promising Practice Award through the Civic Advocacy Network and Kansas State Department of Education. Heath Hogan, Deputy Superintendent introduced Gina Galpin, principal at Bernadine Sitts Intermediate Center. Ms. Galpin introduced students and staff who were involved and stated that they won the Promising Practice Award for classroom discussion and engaging students with civic engagement.
