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The Board of Education of Garden City USD 457 met in regular session on Thursday, June 11, 2020, at 5:30 p.m. in the Board Meeting Room of the Educational Support Center, 1205 Fleming, Garden City, Kansas.

Board members present were Lara Bors, Tim Hanigan, Dana Nanninga, Janene Radke, Mark Rude and Alex Wallace. Also in attendance were Steve Karlin, Superintendent; Heath Hogan, Deputy Superintendent; Glenda LaBarbera, Assistant Superintendent of Student Services; and KJ Knoll, Financial Officer. BOARD RETREAT:

Board Standards - Board members discussed the proposed draft of the board standards. This will be put on the consent agenda for approval at the July 13, 2020 meeting. This will be an item that is discussed in January during new board member orientation, discussed at the June retreat and will be added to the consent agenda at the July organizational meeting every year.

Recap of January 23, 2020 Board Retreat -

- Survey: Dr. Karlin stated that we were on track with Gallup to do the survey but then took a break when COVID-19 happened. He talked about the action planning tool that accompanies the survey and stated that building administrators would need training. Board members discussed. This will be re-evaluated at a fall retreat.
- Board Evaluations: Dr. Karlin suggested that the board standards should be in place before doing board self-evaluations. Board members discussed and there was not enough interest to pursue this topic further at this time.
- Board Policies: Dr. Karlin stated that the board policies are on the district website for public access.
- District Communication Plan: Dr. Karlin stated that we do have one but it is 15 years old. Roy Cessna, Public Information Coordinator and Amanda Harms, Assistant Public Information Coordinator/Deputy Clerk are currently working to update that plan and will present it to the board at a meeting in July or August. Board members discussed. Board members would like to have this as an update to the board on a regular basis.

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Future Board Meeting Topics - Dr. Karlin stated that he would like the Board to give leadership team three topics that align with the board goals to add to the meeting agendas for the 2020-21 school year. Board members discussed how school may be different with COVID-19 guidelines including the budget. Board members discussed that we need to be flexible but need to have the yearly curriculum reports, etc. as usual at the board meetings. Board members discussed the importance of continuing to do the recognitions and building reports to highlight the great things our students and staff are doing but those recognitions and reports may need to be done differently depending on COVID-19 guidelines. The July meetings will include the plan for the 2020-21 school year due to COVID-19. The board members would like to decide on the additional three topics at a fall retreat.

No other official board action took place other than board retreat.

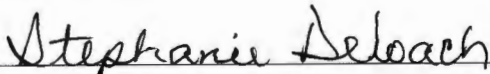

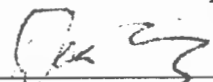
ADJOURNMENT - There being no further business to come before the board, the following action was taken.
