

2022-2023 EXTENDED DAY CENTER PROGRAM

ED CENTER PROGRAM

The ED (Extended Day) Center Program is available for children who need care before and/or after school. Children may attend before school from 6:30 a.m. until the time school starts, and from the end of the school day until 6:00 p.m. Children in the morning program will be able to purchase breakfast at the school cafeteria. Snacks will be provided for the afternoon program.

Any child enrolled in grades K-6 is eligible to attend on a first-come, first-served basis. A registration form must be completed and on file in order for your child to be considered enrolled in the program. Fees must be paid every Monday for services rendered the week prior. If children attend at least three days out of the week, full payment is expected for the entire week.

The weekly fees are \$17 for morning only, \$38 for afternoon only, and \$55 for morning & afternoon. Parents may choose to have their children attend on a daily, rather than a weekly basis. The fee on a daily basis is \$8.00 per day for the morning program and \$13.00 for the afternoon program. Any parent who is late picking up their child will be assessed a late fee.

Opportunities will be provided for study and enrichment. The ED Centers have space for students to do homework, read for pleasure, and participate in recreational and educational activities. Parents are responsible for transportation to and from the program.

SCHOOL CLOSING DELAYED OPENING / EARLY DISMISSAL

The ED Centers are open only when school is in session. If schools are closed due to inclement weather or other emergency, the ED Center will be closed and no charge will be made for that day. If there is a delayed opening or early dismissal due to inclement weather or other emergency, the following procedures will be implemented:

- * ED Centers will be open at 6:30 a.m. even if a delayed opening of school is announced. **There will be an extra charge of \$3.00 for day care if school begins after the normal start time of 8:30 a.m.** This information will be posted at ED Center site(s).
- * If school is cancelled after a delayed opening, parents should pick up their children as soon as possible. The Ed Center will close; therefore parents will need to pick up their children as soon as possible.
- * If an early dismissal occurs before 12:00 noon, the ED Center afternoon session will be cancelled.
- * If an early dismissal occurs after 12:00 noon, the ED Center will be open until 6:00 p.m. **There will be an extra charge of \$3.00 for daycare for the time between early dismissal and the regular dismissal time.** In case of a weather emergency and to ensure the safety of students, parents are encouraged to pick up their children as soon as possible.
