Purpose: The Cardboard Challenge is a celebration of child creativity and the role communities can play in fostering it. Inspired by the short film, "[Caine's Arcade](#)," kids are challenged to create and build games using cardboard, duct tape and their imagination. This provides our students a unique opportunity outside of the classroom to innovate, create and shine!

Challenge Involves:

- Creating a game within a 40 minute class period
- Using only cardboard, duct tape, and imagination as materials
- Taking pictures and/or videos to document the challenge
- Reflecting on the challenge using a video, notes, or pictures
