2) <b>Learn and Demonstrate Employability Skills</b>	<p>Learn employability skills standards through locally developed programs. Employability skills are demonstrated by <b>one</b> of the following:</p> <table border="1" style="width: 100%; border-collapse: collapse;"> <tr> <td style="width: 25%;"><b>Project-Based Learning Experience:</b></td> <td>Allows students to gain knowledge and skills by working for an extended period of time to investigate and respond to an authentic, engaging and complex question to answer, at the appropriate level of challenge. 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(Students must complete <b><i>at least one</i></b> of the following)			Marines	31

	<b>Credential or Certification:</b>	Complete and get certified or credentialed in a State and Industry recognized program approved by the IDOE and the Department of Workforce Development			
	<b>Apprenticeship:</b>	Complete a State, Federal or Industry recognized Apprenticeship. (Apprenticeships are defined as intensive work-based learning experiences that provide a combination of on-the-job training and formal classroom instruction. They are intended to support progressive skill acquisition and lead to postsecondary credentials and, in some cases, degrees)			
	<b>CTE Concentrator:</b>	Career-Technical Education Concentrator. Must earn a C average or higher in approved classes. Can use Perkins IV or Perkins V for Cohorts 2019-2022. Cohorts 2023 and beyond must use Perkins V.
