

## **Precision Machine Metalworking Technology FAQs**

### **Does my student need any previous experience before taking this class?**

No, all students work together and learn as a group

### **If my student attends this course, should they go to college or straight to the workforce?**

Students can go to work, go to college, or serve an apprenticeship upon high school graduation.

### **How much homework can a student expect from this course?**

A majority of the work that students do is in the class. There is a minor amount of homework.

### **What expenses will I incur? Fees, book rental or purchase, tool costs, etc?**

Fees are minimal. Few tools are needed.

### **How does the class look at safety for the students?**

Student's safety is the highest priority. There will be demonstrations on the use of tools and machines. They will be tested on their skills.

### **How much technology is used in the class?**

The class is set up to use the basic skills in the beginning and advances to the area of computerization.

### **Can students get jobs in the field of study?**

Students will learn to create resumes and learn interview skills. They will be able to use these skills to find jobs while they are in the class or after graduation.

### **What kind of salary can a person make with the skills a person learns in this class?**

A person can enter this job market with a starting wage of \$12 - \$15 per hour. Top wages range from \$28 - \$35 per hour.
