

USE OF SCHOOL DISTRICT PROPERTY

School district property, including buildings, grounds, equipment and supplies shall be used only for official school district, educational, community, and/or professional-related purposes in the furtherance of the mission and goals of Topeka Public Schools as determined by the Board of Education and within the limits of Board policies and applicable local, state, and federal law. Any person intending to use school district property off school district premises for purposes as outlined above shall first obtain authorization from the appropriate building or district-level administrator having control over or responsibility for the use of said property.

The superintendent shall develop regulations governing the off campus use of school owned computing devices by students. Such regulations shall require compliance at all times with all Topeka Public Schools' policies and regulations governing acceptable use of computers and use of the internet.
